

### **Pupil Premium**

Pupil premium is additional funding provided to schools for supporting more disadvantaged pupils to ensure they benefit from the same opportunities as all other children. There are three categories of children that qualify for pupil premium:

- Children who are eligible for free school meals (FSM)
- Looked after children or adopted children
- Armed forces children

Schools are free to spend the Pupil Premium as they see fit. However they will be held accountable for how the additional funding to support pupils from low-income families is spent. We are requested to publish online information about how we have used the Premium.
